## **ALTA 2023 Guidelines for Written Papers**

## 1. Copyright

- ALTA's policy is to share copyright with authors, therefore copyright cannot be assigned to a third party.
- Authors are encouraged to publish the abstract on social media before and after the conference.
- Authors cannot publish the full papers on social media.
- Authors can publish full papers on their website, provided there is written acknowledgement that the paper was presented at ALTA 2023.
- Authors may present the paper at another conference after ALTA 2023 provided the paper includes acknowledgement that the paper was first presented at ALTA 2023.
- Authors may publish their paper in third-party publications provided the paper includes acknowledgement it
  was first presented at ALTA 2023.

#### 2. General

- Typical length of papers is 8-15 pages, although longer papers are acceptable.
- Papers must be presented in the English language.
- Papers must have a technical focus; marketing-based papers are not appropriate and will not be accepted.
- **Submit By 31 March 2023** (extensions may be provided on request). Please check submissions carefully as edits will not accepted until post-conference revisions are invited.
- Papers must be submitted in Microsoft Word to enable incorporation into the proceedings. It is helpful to also include a PDF version.

	Title: Arial 10 bold centred below figure (e.g. Figure 1: xxxx)
Tables	Centre on page
	Title: Arial 10 bold centred above table (e.g. <b>Table 1: xxxx</b> )
Images	Use JPEG, PNG or GIF formats to minimize file size
	File size can be reduced by cutting images then using the "Paste Special" function to
	replace them with more economical formats such as JPG, GIF or PNG formats.
References	Insert under main heading "References" as the final section of the paper
	Reference numbering format: 1. 2. 3.
	Include one line space between each reference.
	In the text, use superscripts <b>after</b> the word e.g. $www^{(1)}$ . or $xxx^{(1)(2)}$ or $yyy^{(1-3)}$ or $zzz^{(1)(2)(3)}$
	Do not use end notes or links to references.
Links	Links to websites may be included.
	Do not include links to external documents or data.
Submission	<b>By 31 March 2023</b> (extensions may be provided on request). Please check submissions carefully as edits will not accepted until post-conference revisions are invited.
	Papers must be submitted in <b>Microsoft Word</b> to enable incorporation into the proceedings. It is helpful to also include a PDF version.

#### 3. Corrections

- Edits will be invited by ALTA after the conference prior to production of the final proceedings.
- ALTA will send the master version of papers to presenters for edit and return. Do not send updates your original paper.
- Deadline for submission of post-conference revised papers is **14 June**. If an update is not received by this date, the existing master will be published in the proceedings.

### 4. Proceedings

- Papers will be available to delegates electronically during the conference.
- The final edited proceedings will be sent electronically via download link after the conference (by 31 July).

### 5. Promote Your Paper

- Send your abstract to your client/contact list and invite them to attend.
- Announce your participation via LinkedIn, and Twitter using #ALTA2023.
- Publish your abstract on LinkedIn and into LinkedIn groups using #ALTA2023.
- Publish your abstract on your organisation's website and in newsletters.
